Anyone who lives on the fringes of society or in a solitary zone will not love ice cream. This excludes people who live in Robin's store. It is safe to assume, however, that most people like ice cream. If you look at the professions of peoples and what they say to you, you can draw a conclusion about the types of gifts that they like. For example, Demetrius loves geological objects. Going to a lawyer and buying every beer is an easy way to gain hearts with at least 8-12 villagers. Friday is usually the most popular. Carl's Guide to Stardew Valley Gameplay Strategy and Farm Management Making Friends in Stardew Valley is primarily a matter of conversation and gifts to residents of Pelican and other countries of the game world. Making friends will teach your character new recipes and residents will send gifts in the mail as soon as they like you well enough. It can also lead to your character marrying a villager and they will be your husband or wife. Stardew Valley does allow same-sex marriage for those interested. Heart Meter When you talk to a character, you can hover over the icon in the bottom right corner to see the number of hearts that you have built with them. Building a heart takes time, because of the delays in giving gifts and the fact that there is a bit of decay every day if you don't talk to them (or can't find them!). The heart meter will freeze by 10 if you can max it out - that the villager will be the best friend and no longer need such attention. NPCs who are entitled to marriage - bachelors and bachelors - will have a meter freeze after 8 hearts and require a bouquet (participation) to go How to Make Friends in Stardew Valley: Talking and Giving Gifts to Every Village Resident in Stardew Valley be given one gift a day, up to two a week (with birthdays as an exception and a chance at 3 gifts in one week). To make a gift, just put it on the bar and use the item, hovering over the villager. When they like what you have given them, you will build a part of the heart that indicates how well they love you. If they hate this item, it will lead to a reduction, and not talking to them for a long time may also see these relationships break up. Talking to them once every ten days will stop any breakup and get the relationship to where it was. By interacting with them more often, you can make a profit by simply talking to the villagers on a regular basis. Each of the NPC in the Stardew Valley have likes and dislikes, and gifts can be received in five ways: horrible, bad, neutral, good and great, with dialogue to go along with this reception. A neutral gift costs about the same as talking to them every day, so it's not useless, while a good or great one costs more than 2 or 4 days worth of visits. Just don't give them what they hate. These gifts give different value points, but as long as you stick to good or big (best) gifts for this villager, you will make progress and build friendships. Each level of the heart takes the same amount of effort, so it's not like the level of skill. The quests from Pierre's work board, birthday gifts, and gifts for holidays like the Winter Star Holiday, where you are assigned to Secret Santa, give much more progress in building a heart so take advantage of these opportunities. Look at the calendar next to Pierre to see when the NPC's birthday is during this season, and the list of the best gifts below. Social Tab Click ESC to access the inventory screen. Go to the social tab (heart) and note that it will help you keep track of who you gave gifts to each week (reboot on Sunday). Up to two boxes can be checked, it will help you manage your gift and continues to count. It will also show your current heart level with this villager. This is very convenient when you want to build friendships with multiple NPCs at once for the achievements or evaluations of your grandfather at the beginning of the third year. Marriage in Stardew Valley Getting Married means getting to 10 hearts with one of the bachelors or bachelors below. You must first give them a bouquet bought from Pierre as soon as you reach 8 hearts with them - it opens the 9th and 10th hearts. You can donate a bouquet to more than one NPC while you are not married. Participation means buying a mermaid pendant for 5000g and giving it to a villager as soon as you hit 10 hearts. Buying a pendant means going to the beach while it rains and paying 5000g to the old Mariner. To access the area you have to repair the bridge for 500 wood. It only appears on rainy days. Not snowy and you can't buy it until you're eligible to offer so you can't snag it early to use later. Since you need a double bed to offer, you have to upgrade to upgrade house at least once. The marriage takes place 3 days after giving them the mermaid pendant. If you continue to build a relationship with your spouse, you can have children (with a final home update). Your spouse will help a bit around the farm, and passing 12 hearts will result in your spouse giving you a Stardrop once at random, which increases the maximum energy. This is easy to achieve since you can give your or your wife a gift every day rather than twice a week. Bottom line: Be consistent because of how it all works, it's good to start sooner rather than later if you want your character to get married, or have a lot of friends who teach them cooking recipes. It takes time and some dedication to get the character to 10 hearts, but thankfully you can stay at this point. Talk to them every day, regardless of whether you have a gift for them. Find out where you usually find every NPC and they are usually there, although everyone has a schedule. Sometimes it is better to catch them early when you know where they live. Farming up your favorite type of products is one of the most reliable ways to build a relationship as you can have a gift they love and give it 2x every week. Considering there are 16 weeks a year and one birthday, you could have a good gift twice a week for each villager by making 32 something like and regularly delivering it. The list of gifts Most NPC As a villager can love these items but should not hate them. Some love them and are featured in the big list below. It's not perfect, but should set you in the direction. Look for the NPC name you're trying to make friends with management and F to see if they appear below the list is usually liked items as well as their main entry in the big list. Artisan Goods - most will go more well. Some don't like specific species: Penny and Sebastian with Pale Ale/Wine (Beer Man), some don't like Mayo, Jas and Vincent hate all artisan goods. Coffee - Everyone seems to like it! Cooked items - In addition to bread, hops, fried eggs, sashimi and wheat. Crobus hates cooking, and Willie only likes fish dishes. Some (Emily, Kent, Evelyn) don't like Sashimi Flowers - Most NPCs like flowers, some don't like everything (George) or specific flowers (Elliot with poppies, Jodie, Sebastian, and Maru with Daffodil, and Sebastian with dandelion) Minerals and gems - except for quartz. Leah doesn't like all the gems. Elliot doesn't like limestone /Tigerseye. Fruit tree products - Except for Pierre (Hates Apples).
